5. All flowers should be named where possible (cards available at entry desk).
6. Entries are unlimited
7. Collection of exhibits. The Centenary Pavilion will close to the public at 4 pm on Sunday with stewards only permitted to remain inside.
8. The pavilion will reopen at 5.00PM (normal collection time) for exhibitors with exhibit tickets only. No one other than exhibitors will be admitted. Pavilion to close at 5.30pm
9. DISTINCT - each bloom must be distinct from the other
10. NND (not necessarily distinct) Two or more blooms may be the same variety or cultivar.
11. The Schedule will be judged according to the standards of the Royal Horticultural Society of NSW
