**SUBSTITUTION FEE:** \$10 per substitution. All subs must be paid by 5pm Friday 19th

April 2024

**PRIZE MONEY:** Can be collected from the Show Office between the hours of 3pm

to 5pm Friday of the show 11am to 1pm & 2pm to 5pm on Saturday of the how & 11am to 1pm & 2.30pm to 4pm on the Sunday of the show. Prize money will be paid according to the Awards made by the Judges Book, duly signed by the judge, ALL prize monies must be collected by 30th June or will be forfeited.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Two vehicles passes from 123Tix per exhibitor will be issued, (one

car, one truck) Truck + vehicle rego numbers must be supplied: these Passes are not transferrable and will be scanned on entry.

Entry via Gate 5. Check with Chief Steward for parking designated area. No vehicle entry after 9am.

#### COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. Competitors enter at their own risk.

- 2. Fireworks Saturday 8pm.
- 3. TIME OF ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: All cattle in Breed Classes & LED Steer Competition must be at Dubbo Showground by 7am Saturday.
- 4. LED Stud Cattle & Steers are to remain on the showground until 12pm Sunday.
- 5. Heifers in Heifer Show & Junior Competitors must be at the showground by 8am Friday must remain until 12pm Sunday of the Show.
- **6.** Prize money is available to collect from Secretary's Office from 12pm Sunday 12th May.
- 7. No access to the cattle shed before 12pm Thursday prior to the Show.
- **8.** WORKING WITH CHILDREN Exhibitors must comply with all Working with Children Legislation (see EXHIBITORS Regulations for details).

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- PESTIVIRUS Lab test results must be provided for each animal that is entered at
  the Dubbo Show Beef Cattle section including calves at foot. Results are to be
  provided with entries otherwise they will NOT BE ACCEPTED. Pesti Virus lab results
  must highlight the identification of the animal.
- 2. AGE REQUIREMENTS No children under 18 years of age will be permitted to lead a bull any age in Paraders Competitions.
- **3. AGE & DATE OF BIRTH** The age of cattle & competitors will be taken as at the first day of the show (Friday 10th May 2024) & will be determined by years instead of teeth. Birth dates & class numbers MUST be completed on entry forms.
- 4. BEDDING & STALLS- Bedding is provided by the Society for each exhibit. Stalls will be allocated by the Society to each exhibitor. These allocations are to be strictly adhered to unless the chief steward states otherwise. Additional bedding for topping up stalls will be available to those exhibitors remaining on showground for the duration of the show.
- 5. BREEDERS GROUP ENTRY REQUIREMENTS All Exhibits in the breeder's group must be BRED & OWNED by the exhibitor & drawn from competitive classes. The group must consist of three animals, (with the exception of calves at foot) The Group must have each gender represented i.e. two bulls & one female, or vice versa.
- SIRE'S PROGENY CLASS ENTRY REQUIREMENTS Exhibits in the sire's progeny group are to be drawn from the competitive classes. The group must consist of

- three animals, (except for calves at foot) with both sexes to be represented. The Name of sire is to be stated on Entry Form. All Exhibits in the class "MUST BE OWNED BY THE EXHIBITOR".
- 7. CALVES AT FOOT Calves must be under 9 months of age & still sucking of the mother. Calves must be stalled with its mother & although tethered, must always have unrestricted access to her. Additional space for Calves MUST be nominated on the Entry Forms. Calves must be entire (i.e. no steers). Calves do not have to be registered if only being shown at mothers' side but MUST be FULLY ELIGIBLE for registration. Calves do not need to be tattooed if only being shown at mothers' side. All calves at foot to be natural born calves, not an ET Calf.
- 8. BREED CLASSES Each breed must have at least two exhibitors within any breed. If there are not more than ten individual exhibits of any breed, they will then be included into ANY OTHER BREED class.
- 9. CLEANING OF STALLS Each exhibitor is responsible for the removal of all manure from the stall in which their exhibit/s are stalled. All stalls to be cleaned out by 7am each morning. Waste is to be placed in the designated area.
- **10. CAMPING** Unauthorised Campers will not be permitted & will be requested to vacate the showground.
- **11. DOGS** No dogs are permitted within or near the cattle shed or judging lawns.
- 12. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT All exhibitors electrical equipment must have an in-line circuit breaker, & all power leads must have a current certificate from a registered electrician, as required by law. These will be randomly checked by the Dubbo Show Society Safety Officer.
- 13. GRAND PARADE The Grand Parade is Saturday at 2.30pm. ALL BROAD RIBBON WINNERS MUST PARADE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR COLLECTION OF PRIZE MONEY. Any animal, whether a ribbon winner or not, may parade. NO HANDLER UNDER 12 YEARS OF AGE IS PERMITTED TO LEAD IN THE GRAND PARADE except for calves at foot if accompanied by an adult. Adequate halter restraints must be used. Exception due to safety is at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- **14. STUD EXHIBITOR PASS**: A Stud Exhibitor Pass consisting of three (3) x 3-day passes must be purchased for \$55 at the time of submission of entries. These passes will not be available at any other time, Additional One Day \$15 passes may be pre purchased at time of submission of entries if wished. Passes are available for collection prior to the show.
- 15. HEALTH REGULATIONS Any animal infected by ringworm or warts will be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the show. The Society will report any animal they believe to be infected by ringworm or warts to the Society's Veterinarian who will inspect such animals for the purpose of determining whether the animal is so infected. Completed Health Declarations & PIC numbers MUST accompany entry forms.
- **16. JOHNE'S DISEASE** Except where the Society may determine otherwise, no cattle may be exhibited unless from a herd, stud or property for which a Johne's Disease Health Declaration has been submitted to the Cattle Section by the closing date of entries. Completed Johne's Declaration MUST accompany entry forms. JBAS Score 6 & above.

- 17. JUDGING The Society may change the judge for any class, at any time, if it deems fit. No exhibit shall receive an award, if in the opinion of the judge, it is unworthy of such award. The decision of the Judge as to the merits of the exhibit & the competitor shall be final & binding.
- 18. MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR will be awarded on a point score basis: 1st 3points; 2nd 2points; 3rd 1 point; Grand Champion 3 points; Champion 2 points; Reserve Champion 1 point. Breeds of less than twenty exhibits will receive the "Most Successful Exhibitor Award".
- **19. PREPARATION OF EXHIBITS** The use of powered cattle washers is prohibited. Grooming/clipping chutes are allowed but can only be put in the designated area.
- 20. RECOGNISED BREED SOCIETY All exhibits in the stud classes must have been fully accepted for registration by a RECOGNISED CATTLE BREED SOCIETY, proof of this registration & ownership must accompany the entry form. An entire copy of the registration certificate MUST be provided for each exhibit, accompanying Entry Forms.
- 21. RIBBONS & PRIZEMONEY In a single class, a ribbon or other evidence of a previous award shall not be worn or displayed in the ring. Ribbons may be awarded throughout the cattle section in accordance with the following 5 exhibits & under up to 3 ribbons; 6 to 10 exhibits 4 ribbons; 11 to 15 exhibits 5 ribbons.
- 22. PRIZE MONEY &/or product will be awarded as follows Champion \$40; Reserve Champion \$20 & or equivalent. Where insufficient numbers, classes may be combined to become Junior/Senior classes. Trophies will not be presented in any breed unless there is competition within that breed (i.e.: more than one exhibitor).
- 23. SECURITY OF ANIMALS All bulls over 6 months & under 12 months must have a nose clip or be rung through the nose with ALL bulls 12 months & over to be rung with it being always used while being led. All female exhibits over 6 months must have a nose clip or ring. All exhibits must be provided with effective halters & are to be thoroughly broken to lead. All exhibitors must provide neck straps or neck collars for their cattle & they are to be always used when the cattle are stalled. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to tend to their cattle & make sure they do not get tangled.
- **24. STALLS** There is to be no gear placed at the cattle stalls except for a rake stand & wheelbarrow to maintain the width of the aisle. Large quantities of feed & excess gear should be left in vehicles & only be brought out at feeding time or when needed. Any equipment left at the cattle stalls is left there at the owner's risk. Each exhibitor is permitted to display signage in the cattle sheds. Curtains & animal name cards are encouraged to make the stall area look nicer.
- 25. TIME OF ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE All cattle in breed classes & led steer competition must be at Dubbo showground Friday of the Show. Led stud cattle & steers are to remain on the showground until 12pm Sunday of the Show. Heifers in Heifer show & junior competitors must be at the showground by 8am Friday & cannot leave until the completion of presentations on Sunday. Cattle can commence arriving at the Dubbo showgrounds Thursday prior to the show at 12 noon.

- **26. LATE ENTRIES** Late entries will be accepted one week after closing, **\$50** late entry fee will apply.
- **27. SUBSTITUTION** Substitutions are not classified as a late entry. Substitution fee \$10 per substitution. Substitutions need to be from the same class i.e., age & will be accepted only until one week after Entries Close.
- 28. TROPHY & BROAD RIBBON CLASSES Grand champion male & female from each breed are to compete in the interbreed judging where all cattle judges from the day all decide on one champion male & one champion female who then go on to compete against each other for the interbreed supreme exhibit of the Dubbo show. Each winning breeders' group from each breed shall also compete in the interbreed judging for the interbreed champion breeders' group. There is to be NO substitution of animals for all classes.
- **29. CONDUCT**: All competitors are to enter & leave their respective rings in a dignified manner. Any person whose conduct toward another person is found to be objectionable may be asked to leave the Showground & may be subject to future disqualification & banned from other Show Societies. Likewise, the Committee reserves the right to ask a competitor to leave a judging ring if it is in their opinion a competitor is behaving in an unsuitable manner.
- **30.** The Committee reserves the right of refusing or cancelling any entry, without giving reasons by doing so. The decision of the Committee on all points shall be final & no correspondence will be entered into.
- **31.** The Committee reserves the right to adjudicate on any questionable entry or other point not provided for in the Rules &/or Regulations of the Society, & of making any alterations that may be deemed necessary.
