- 1. Each fleece is eligible in one Class only.
- 2. Rams fleece not eligible, except in Classes 3711, 3712 & 3719
- 3. Fleeces from sheep that have been housed or rugged are eligible to be shown in Class 3706 only. A Qualified Classer will be in attendance to place fleeces in their correct Classes. Plastic wool bags are available from the Show Office on Showground. Wool exhibits must have your name, section, & class plainly your entry card inside bag & your name & address on outside of bag. Entries must be made at the Show Society office where your entry card will be issued.
- 4. All wool to be 2023/2024 shearing & not more than 13 months grown. Fleeces to be grown by Exhibitors in all Classes. All fleeces to be skirted.
- 5. Unhoused fleeces are not to be housed or rugged for twelve months prior to show.

6. COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS. The Centenary Pavilion will close to the public at 4pm on Sunday with stewards only permitted to remain inside. The pavilion will reopen at 5pm for exhibitors with exhibit tickets only. No-one other than exhibitors will be admitted. Exhibits must be collected by 6pm due to change in storage conditions, the Show Society will not be responsible for fleeces left after the Show.
