**LATE ENTRIES:** Not accepted.

**PRIZE MONEY:** 1<sup>st</sup> \$4 plus card, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$2 plus card  
Junior section 1<sup>st</sup> \$3 plus card, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$2 plus card. Prize money can be collected from the Show Office during office hours until June 30.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** Once an entry is entered against a class there will be no variances accepted to this entry.

### **CONDITIONS:**

1. **COMPETITORS** Enter at their own risk.
2. **WORKING WITH CHILDREN** Exhibitors must comply with all Working with Children legislation (*see Exhibitors Regulations for details*)
3. All exhibits except Decorative must be grown by the exhibitor & have been in his or her possession for at least three months.
4. No entries will be accepted at the show office. Any entered at the show office will not be accepted in the Pavilion.
5. Once an entry is entered against a class there will be no variances accepted to this entry.
6. Society will exercise the utmost care but cannot accept responsibility for the loss of or damage to any exhibits.
7. Entries are unlimited.
8. **COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS** The Centenary Pavilion will close to the public at 4pm on Sunday with stewards only permitted to remain inside.
9. The pavilion will reopen at 5pm (*normal collection time*) for exhibitors with exhibit tickets only. No one other than exhibitors will be admitted. Pavilion to close at 5.30pm
10. **DISTINCT** each bloom must be distinct from the other.

11. NND (*not necessarily distinct*) Two or more blooms may be the same variety or cultivar.
12. The Schedule will be judged according to the standards of the Royal Horticultural Society of NSW
