- 3. Exhibits which have already been shown at a previous exhibition of the Dubbo Show Society are barred from competing at this Exhibition.
- **4.** Exhibits will not be returned by post unless postage is prepaid.
- 5. Judging commences at 10am Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024. Judges' decisions in awarding prizes are unrestricted & final.
- 6. Stewards who are exhibitors must not be in the vicinity of the judges while they are judging. Any breaches will result in entries being disqualified from judging.
- Exhibitors are to place in LOWER RIGHT-HAND CORNER on each exhibit the class in which it is entered also name & address on back of each exhibit.
- 8. On payment of Entry Fee, exhibitors will receive a perforated card. Please retain smaller section & present this when collecting exhibits.
- 9. No exhibit over 85cm x 85cm accepted This includes the frame.
- WORKING WITH CHILDREN Exhibitors must comply with all Working with Children legislation. (See Exhibitors Regulations for details)
- 11. One ENTRY per person, per class.
- 12. All entries to be completed by the exhibitor within the last 2 years & not been entered previously.

# SCHOOL & PRESCHOOL ENTRIES

Due to the increasing popularity of this section & the limitations of space in the Pavilion there is a revised process required to address this.

IT IS REQUESTED THAT ALL TEACHERS / SCHOOLS PREPARING ENTRIES AGAINST CLASSES 4475 - 4480 ADHERE TO INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

Classes **4475**– **4480** to be on separate sheets of butchers' paper so that the paper can be attached to the top of the display board, **NO more than 16 x A5 size** deep MUST BE LANDSCAPE ONLY WITH 4CM MARGIN at top & bottom.

- Classes 4475 4480 School entries should be attached close together (with NO paper showing between entries) NO more than 16 x A5 size deep. MUST BE LANDSCAPE ONLY WITH 4CM MARGIN at top & bottom.
- 2. Classes 4475-4480: Exhibit cards to be placed in lower right-hand corner. All School entries to be in numerical order, name of child & school on back of each entry.
- Classes 4475 4480: There is to be only one A5 Landscape sheet with School emblem or Logo situated at 1st row in the 1st A5 sheet on each strip of butcher's paper (top left-hand corner).
- **4.** Collection of exhibits. The only time articles can be collected from the Centenary Pavilion is as follows; The Centenary Pavilion will close to the public at 4pm on Sunday with stewards only permitted to remain inside. The pavilion will reopen at 5pm for exhibitors with exhibit tickets only to collect their articles.
